AUTOMOTIVE I	AUTO 102 (T&I) 8506T1	75.0	\$340.00	Mon/Wed or Tues/Thurs
Theory & Operation - This course covers the fundamentals associated with a career path in the automotive field. The student will be provided with the basic knowledge and entry-level skills required to successfully service, diagnose and troubleshoot modern automobiles. Preparedness for the ASE (Automotive Service Excellence) Brakes exam is emphasized.

Servicing - This course covers the automotive systems theory, diagnosis, and repair. It also prepares students to experience automobile servicing. This class will cover servicing procedures of steering systems, diagnosis, and repair. Preparedness for the ASE (Automotive Service Excellence) Steering and Suspension exam is emphasized.				
AUTOMOTIVE III	AUTO 302 (T&I) 8507T3	75.0	\$340.00	Mon/Wed
Electrical - The course covers the fundamentals of electronic and electrical systems. Laboratory experiences will include shop safety, Scan-tool applications, body electric components, electrical fundamentals, schematic reading, and OBD II troubleshooting. Preparedness for the ASE (Automotive Service Excellence) Electrical exam is emphasized.				
AUTOMOTIVE IV	AUTO 402 (T&I) 8508T4	75.0	\$340.00	Mon/Wed
Troubleshooting-The course will allow the student to perform acquired skills in troubleshooting and the diagnosis of problems with the use of Scan-tools and manufacturer diagnostic procedures for correct diagnosis. A strong emphasis will be placed on customer relations and communications. Preparedness for the ASE (Automotive Service Excellence) Engine Performance exam is emphasized.				
AUTOMATIC TRANS	AUTO 304 (T&I) 8711T5	75.0	\$340.00	Tues/Thurs
Theory-This course provides instruction in the construction, operation, and problem diagnosis of current model automatic transmissions used in passenger cars and light trucks. Students are prepared in the area for practical experiences they will typically encounter.

Complete machining of an engine including boring, milling cylinder heads, replace valve guides and valve seats, fitting piston pins, and connecting rods reconditioning.

Outboard & Inboard Services: This course is designed to prepare the student to diagnose, troubleshoot, make repairs, and maintain both outboard and inboard marine engines. Students are prepared in servicing and winterizing boats/marine equipment.				
SMALL ENGINES	Eng 112 (T&I) 8727T1	75.0	\$340.00	Tues/Thurs
This course concentrates on the repair of small engines used in lawn and garden equipment. Theory operation of small engine fuel, ignition, cooling systems, internal engine parts, adjustments and parts alignments is covered.
