<b>BARBERING I</b>	<b>Barber 100 (APP) 8740A1</b>	<b>75.0</b>	<b>\$350.00</b>	<b>Tues/Thurs</b>
Theory study of the structure and function of the skin, common skin disorders, and scalp and hair disorders are the focus of this semester. Hands on classes include providing facial massages, rendering plain facials, and barbering services such as cutting hair, styling hair, preparing customers for haircuts. The conduct required for a successful barber is stressed along with successful relationships with employers, clients, and coworkers. (One semester – 75 hours)				
<b>BARBERING II</b>	<b>Barber 200 (APP) 8742A2</b>	<b>75.0</b>	<b>\$350.00</b>	<b>Mon/Tues Mon/Wed</b>
This program prepares students to cut, shampoo, and style hair. Special attention is given to hygiene, safety, skin, scalp, diseases, and equipment sterilization. Included is the study of sales, business management, and customer relations. Instruction qualifies student for the State Barber certification examination. Prerequisite: BARBERING I (One semester - 75 hours)				
<b>COSMETOLOGY I</b>	<b>COS 111 (APP) 8527A1</b>	<b>75.0</b>	<b>\$350.00</b>	<b>Mon/Wed Tues/Thurs</b>
This course allows a student to gain a basic understanding of skills required to become a cosmetologist. The student will be required to demonstrate an understanding of procedures and methods to complete the following tasks: manicure/pedicure, facials, body massages, shampooing, rinsing, scalp and hair care, finger waving, hair styling, permanent waving, hair coloring, hair sculpting, make-up, bacteriology, haircutting and sanitation methods. (One semester - 75 hours)				
<b>COSMETOLOGY II</b>	<b>COS 211 (APP) 8528A2</b>	<b>75.0</b>	<b>\$350.00</b>	<b>Mon/Wed Tues/Thurs</b>
This is the second half of the cosmetology program which provides application of concepts and skills learned in Cosmetology I. Instruction will also focus on business management, customer relations, classroom and practical experiences to prepare students for the state board licensing examination. Prerequisite: COSMETOLOGY I (One semester - 75 hours)

This course will teach students the anatomy of natural hair, various types of braiding including box braids, twists, and track braids, ergonomics, hair types, and many other areas a professional natural hairstylist needs. The course is designed to prepare students for the State Board examination.				
<b>NAILS TECHNOLOGY</b>	<b>NAILS 100 (APP) 8693 A1</b>	<b>75.0</b>	<b>\$350.00</b>	<b>Tues/Thurs</b>
Students will learn how to recognize healthy nails and skin as well as nail and skin disorders and provide services to enhance the look of their client’s hands and feet by performing manicures, pedicures, applying sculptured nails, gel nails, nail tips and nail wraps using the latest nail technology while following proper sanitation, disinfections, and safety procedures.
